For nearly 60 years, the congregation of the Cathedral of the Rockies has had a graded choir program in which children age 3 on up may participate. Presently, all of our children's choirs meet on Wednesday afternoons as part of the Wonderful Wednesday Program. The youth music program includes all of our musicians from middle-childhood through early college and features our own Wesley Boy's Choir, Jubilation Girl's Choir, and the Epworth Chorale. With the support of the congregation, the Chorale has had the great fortune to go on a week-long tour each year for more than 50 years. The Chorale tours in cooperation with the Cathedral Bell Choir — a 6+ octave English handbell choir that has travelled internationally and has been featured at two world's fairs in its history.
